Police Investigate Menangle Break and Enter

Camden police are calling for public assistance after a break and enter in Menangle on Wednesday.

A man was seen leaving a house on Menangle Road about 11.40am on Wednesday.

The police said he produced a pistol when two relatives of the home owner confronted him as he left the house and threatened them.

He then escaped on what is believed to be a green Kawasaki Ninja motorcycle or similar which was parked in front of the house and rode towards Campbelltown.

Police would like to speak to the man on the motorbike in relation to the investigation.

He wore a dark-coloured hooded top, dark-coloured tracksuit pants and was carrying a dark-coloured back pack with red markings and wore a white motorcycle helmet.

The Fultons are now serving with Mission Aviation Fellowship in Arnhem Land. Initially, Craig joined MAF as a pilot but, just as cream rises to the top, after two years living and flying on Milingimbi Island Craig now heads up the team of pilots/engineers/IT staff in Gove.

The photo that appears above was taken at the Fultons' recent visit to St James at which Craig and Red gave an outline of their current responsibilities. Red particularly wanted to highlight the plight of our aboriginal brothers and sisters who still have a significantly shorter life expectancy. Death from preventable diseases and suicide (especially among the young people) are lamentably all too common. Red said that the SBS TV program, "First Contact" should be viewed by all non-indigenous Australians.

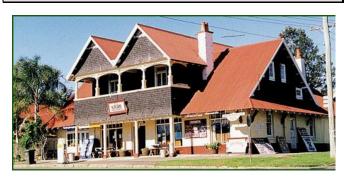
