Three local RFS stations received upgrades

The great volunteers at three Wollondilly Rural Fire Service brigades have new facilities thanks to South32 Illawarra Metallurgical Coal.

The mining company provided almost \$100,000 in funding for extensions to the Douglas Park, Menangle and Wilton brigades.

The Douglas Park shed upgrade has provided additional equipment storage for the volunteers and ensures members have adequate facilities to perform maintenance and ongoing training activities.

The Wilton fire station extension provides extra space to house fire trucks and a change room for members.

The upgrade to the Menangle fire station offers enhanced training facilities and amenities for the brigade and allows it to host functions and meetings for the local community.
